

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Africa Mission Training Institute (AMTI) admits for study into Certificate and Diploma programs, such candidates, who are academically qualified, and who accept the Institute's Christian mission and philosophy, without regard or preference to gender, ethnic origin, race, or physical disability being imposed as a condition for being a student.

To qualify for admission into the **Diploma Programs**, the applicants must:

- a). Have an overall grade of C- (minus) in KCSE or 1 advanced level pass or their equivalence for candidates from outside Kenya; **OR**
- **b).** A post-secondary Certificate from a recognized tertiary training institution with an overall cumulative grade of 2.5 GPA or equivalence on a four-point scale; **OR**
- c). Mature Age Qualification which meets the following conditions:
 - i). The candidate must be at least 25 years of age on 1st July for the year in which admission is sought.
 - ii). The candidate should have completed their full-time secondary school education and worked full-time for at least three years in an area that is relevant to the Diploma into which admission is being sought.
 - iii). The candidate must take and pass with a score of at least 65% in each of the pre-admission examination papers administered by AMTI, one in the English language and the other on General Knowledge. To take these papers, the applicant must make a booking with the Academic Dean and pay a fee of Ksh.2000. Application for the admission into the Diplomas programs under the Mature Entry provision should only be made after the applicant has been declared as having passed the two examinations.

To qualify for admission into the **Certificate Program**, the applicants must:

- a). Have an overall grade of D (plain) in KCSE or its equivalence for candidates from outside Kenya; **OR**
- **b).** Have a pass grade in KCSE and provide evidence of additional training through formal or non-formal training that that may be deemed by the Academic Council as adequate to have raised the level of academic standards of the applicant to a level of D (plain) in KCSE; **OR**
- c). Mature Age Qualification which meets the following conditions:
- i). The candidate must be at least 25 years of age on 1st July for the year in which admission is sought.

- ii). The candidate should have completed their full-time primary school education and worked full-time for at least five years in an environment that, in the opinion of the Academic Council, may be deemed to be academically stimulating.
- iii). The candidate must take and pass with a score of at least 65% in each of the preadmission examination papers administered by AMTI, one in the English language and the other on General Knowledge. To take these papers, the applicant must make a booking with the Registrar and pay a fee of Ksh.2000. Application for the admission into the Certificate programs under the Mature Entry provision should only be made after the applicant has been declared as having passed the two examinations.

For both the Certificate and Diplomas, an application fee of <u>Ksh.500</u> is payable upon submission of the filled application form by the applicant. - c). Mature Age Qualification which meets the following conditions:
 - i). The candidate must be at least 25 years of age on 1st July for the year in which admission is sought.
 - ii). The candidate should have completed their full-time secondary school education and worked full-time for at least three years in an area that is relevant to the Diploma into which admission is being sought.
 - iii). The candidate must take and pass with a score of at least 65% in each of the pre-admission examination papers administered by AMTI, one in the English language and the other on General Knowledge. To take these papers, the applicant must make a booking with the Academic Dean and pay a fee of Ksh.2000. Application for the admission into the Diplomas programs under the Mature Entry provision should only be made after the applicant has been declared as having passed the two examinations.

To qualify for admission into the **Certificate Program**, the applicants must:

- a). Have an overall grade of D (plain) in KCSE or its equivalence for candidates from outside Kenya; **OR**
- **b).** Have a pass grade in KCSE and provide evidence of additional training through formal or non-formal training that that may be deemed by the Academic Council as adequate to have raised the level of academic standards of the applicant to a level of D (plain) in KCSE; **OR**
- c). Mature Age Qualification which meets the following conditions:
- i). The candidate must be at least 25 years of age on 1st July for the year in which admission is sought.
- ii). The candidate should have completed their full-time primary school education and worked full-time for at least five years in an environment that, in the opinion of the Academic Council, may be deemed to be academically stimulating.
- iii). The candidate must take and pass with a score of at least 65% in each of the preadmission examination papers administered by AMTI, one in the English language and

the other on General Knowledge. To take these papers, the applicant must make a booking with the Registrar and pay a fee of Ksh.2000. Application for the admission into the Certificate programs under the Mature Entry provision should only be made after the applicant has been declared as having passed the two examinations.
